Two Rivers Announces New Parks and Recreation Director

Kevin Boehm, who currently serves as Parks and Recreation Director in Enid, Oklahoma, will take the leadership of Two Rivers' Parks and Recreation Department on April 30.

He replaces Judy Goodchild, who retired on April 2 after 23 years with the department, the past ten as Director.

A Kenosha native, Boehm has over 20 years of parks and recreation experience. He worked for 15 years at the Waukegan, Illinois Park District, in maintenance, construction and special events. He then worked for 2 and a half years with the City of Madison, Wisconsin as a playground technician, before advancing to the position of Director in Enid in 2015.

Boehm earned his B.S. degree in Parks and Recreation Management from Northern Arizona University, in 2014.

As Director of Parks and Recreation for that northern Oklahoma city of 50,000, he supervises a staff of 19 full-time employees and dozens of part-time and seasonal workers.

Commenting on his new position in Two Rivers, Boehm stated: “I am honored to have been selected to fill the Park and Recreation Director position within the city. I have some very big shoes to fill stepping in to Judy’s position, however, I am excited for the challenge. I look forward to celebrating the history of Two Rivers while leading the Park and Recreation Department into the future. I can’t wait to become a member of the community and get started serving the citizens of Two Rivers.”

City Manager Greg Buckley noted that Boehm was selected from a field of 29 applicants. That group was initially narrowed to five semi-finalists, then two finalists who returned to Two Rivers on March 24 for one more interview with the City Manager and Department Heads.

“We were very pleased with the caliber of the candidates for this position,” Buckley stated. “The level of interest in the position is a reflection of the commitment our City leaders have made to quality park facilities and recreation programs here in Two Rivers, and the outstanding job that Judy Goodchild and her team have done over the past ten years.”

Buckley added: “The Two Rivers Parks and Rec Department is a huge contributor to the quality of life in our city. We have high expectations, and are confident that Kevin’s passion, knowledge and experience will serve him, the department and the community well.”
