**Coming soon! Two Rivers Water & Light will soon meet more of its customers' local electric needs with clean, cost-effective power from the sun through a new project – the Point Beach Solar Energy Center.**

Two Rivers's newest renewable energy resource, will begin construction in August 2020 and be completed in October 2021.

#### **Project Overview:**

- Located in Manitowoc County; adjacent to the existing Point Beach Nuclear Plant near Two Rivers, Wis.
- Owned and operated by a subsidiary of NextEra Energy Resources, LLC.
- A 100-megawatt photovoltaic solar energy generating facility
- Construction to begin August 2020, anticipated completion in October 2021

#### **Benefits:**

- Delivers safe, clean, renewable energy to Two Rivers Water & Light customers
- Generates increased tax revenue and good-paying jobs for the region
- Create 300-400 jobs during its construction period

With the addition of safe, clean, renewable energy from Point Beach Solar Energy Center, WPPI Energy will be on track to achieve about a 37% overall reduction in CO<sub>2</sub> emissions from 2005 levels by 2025.
