City of Two Rivers (population 11,457) seeks qualified candidates to direct and administer the City's Community Development and Planning functions.

Two Rivers is an historic, Lake Michigan coastal community with exceptional outdoor recreational opportunities, located 90 minutes north of Milwaukee and 45 minutes southeast of Green Bay.

Natural assets include 3,000 acre Point Beach State Forest, just north of the City and 1,700 acre Woodland Dunes Nature Center just to the west. Tourism assets include a highly popular public beach, growing network of bike trails, sport fishing on Lake Michigan, canoe/kayak trails on area rivers, and many local festivals and special events.

The City is focused on redeveloping its extensive waterfront areas along the East and West Twin Rivers and promoting new commercial and residential investment. A Main Street Community since 1996, Two Rivers' historic downtown is also a focus of redevelopment activity.

This newly-created position reports to the City Manager and is responsible for initiating, directing and supervising all matters related to community development and city planning. Position supervises full and part-time Zoning and Inspections staff.

Successful candidate will administer all community and business development loan and incentive programs, city marketing activities, TIF districts, redevelopment, blight elimination, brownfields and housing assistance programs. Works with developers as needed. Oversees and implements policies regarding the City's industrial parks; administers all grants related to community and economic development.

Bachelor's Degree with major course work in planning, geography, economics, business or public administration, business finance or a related field is required, along with a minimum of seven (7) years in the economic development and or planning profession.

Salary range \$86,570 - \$112,965 annually, generous benefit package.
