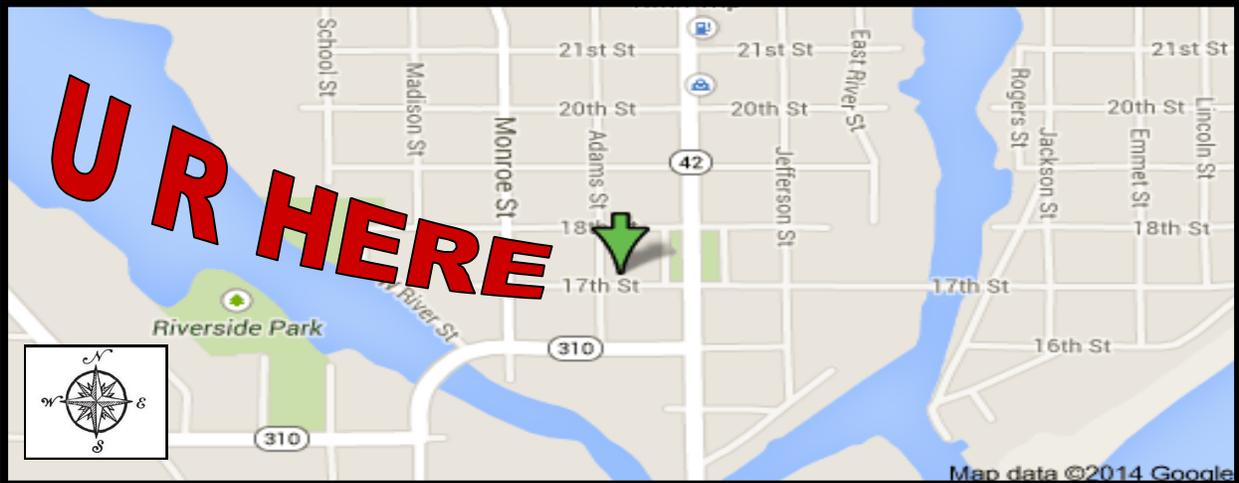

Cemetery Clean Up

Twice per year: spring and fall, all decorations, natural or artificial, including solar lights, are to be removed from grave spaces to allow for general clean-up of the cemeteries.

Remove Winter decorations by April 15.

New Summer decorations may be placed after May 15.

Remove Summer decorations by October 15.

New Winter decorations may be placed after November 15.

Note: Anyone desiring to retain their summer and winter decorations, natural and artificial (including solar lights), must remove decorations annually prior to the above clean up dates.

Program Fees

Most programs/classes have different fees for residents and non-residents. **Any person who lives within the city limits and pays taxes to the city of Two Rivers is eligible for the resident fee (R). All other registrants must pay the non-resident fee (N).** All classes are filled on a first-come, first-served basis. If a program is full, your name will be placed on a waiting list and you will be notified if/when an opening occurs. As soon as we have received your payment, you will be registered in the class.
