

YARD WASTE

- Yard waste may not be put into the garbage as they have been banned from state landfill sites.
- Yard waste can be taken to one of the Manitowoc County Composting Sites:

(1/2 mile south of HWY 310)**

Yard waste such as grass, leaves, and garden waste are acceptable as is chippable brush (6 in or less in diameter, 5 ft. or less in length) Stumps and un-chippable wood are not considered yard waste and should be disposed at:

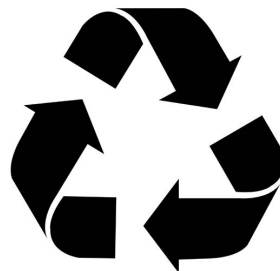

WHAT SHOULD YOU BE RECYCLING?



Recycling Guidelines



Paper

Includes newspapers, junk mail, magazines, computer paper, books with metal or plastic binding removed, etc. Paper should be clean and dry. No paper contaminated with food or oil. No paper coated with foil, plastic or heavy glue. No plastic/foil wrapping paper.



Glass Bottles

Any color glass bottle or jar can be recycled. Remove lids or caps and rinse. No window glass, mirrors, light bulbs, clay, ceramics, drinking glasses or ovenware. No broken glass.



Cardboard

Should be clean and flattened. No soiled cardboard or cardboard coated with wax, tin, or plastic.



Plastic

Check for a neck. We only accept #1 and #2 bottles and jars. Remove the caps, rinse and flatten. No tub shaped containers or bottles that contained oil or pesticide (even if rinsed). No plastic wrap, films, bags, trays, pails, packaging peanuts, styrofoam, or any other non-bottle shaped item. Please do not tie milk jugs together or tie in plastic bags.



Cartons

Cartons include shelf stable and refrigerated containers for wine, milk, juice, cream, soy milk, soup, and egg substitutes. They should be emptied, rinsed, and flattened.



Cans

Tin, steel, and aluminum cans. Coated cans, foil, and pie tins are OK. Empty and rinse out food residue.

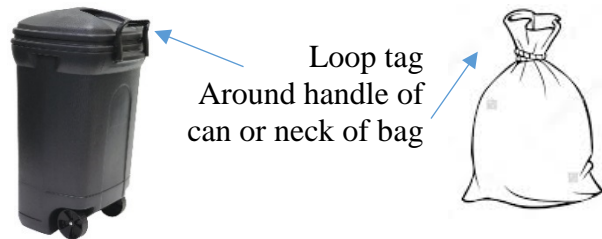

**CITY OF TWO RIVERS
GARBAGE COLLECTION**

EACH 30 gallons of garbage placed on the curb will require a **GARBAGE ONLY** sticker. Garbage containers with stickers will be picked up. The sticker must be attached to the outside of the bags or on the handle of the trash can(s).



GARBAGE may be contained in:

- 30-gallon garbage cans
- 30-gallon plastic bags
- Any multiples of above

Example:

3 – 30 gallon bags = 3 stickers

3 – 30-gallon garbage cans = 3 stickers
