

5. Per Council Action at the March 28 Work Session, Engineering Dept. Has Submitted Applications to WisDOT for 80 Percent Funding (Federal Infrastructure Bill Monies) to Resurface the Following Streets in 2023:

- --Pierce Street from 22nd to Zlatnik
- --School Street from 10th to 14th
- --Neshotah Road from Zlatnik to CTH O




9. City Manager's Report, April 4, 2022 C. Status/Update Reports 7. City Facade Improvement Grants are Available; Deadline for First Round of Applications is April 15

Program's goal is to encourage investment in the façade of commercial buildings. Eligible improvements include but are not limited to masonry repair, or exterior painting, to be made on buildings located within identified areas in the City.

Program offers 50 percent reimbursement <u>up to</u> \$10,000 of actual cost of the façade rehabilitation. Applicants must match grant amount with funding from other sources.



R.W. Baird earlier today sold the City's 10-Year Notes for financing of 2022 capital projects.

Interest rate obtained was **3.03 percent**, within the maximum of **3.25 percent allowed under the parameters** resolution approved by City Council on March **7**.

13. Other

City Application for **Idle Sites Grant Funding** to assist developer Art Dumke/TRivers, LLC in renovating the former Paragon property (purchased on March 17, 2022)is being reviewed by the WI Economic Development Corporation.

Staff is currently working on a **Development Agreement** related to this funding assistance, for which the City is the pass-through.

Such an agreement is required for an Idle Sites grant award; expect to see the agreement brought to Council for action on April 18 or possibly a special meeting before that date, if necessary.

Trivers, LLC plans to invest more than \$7 million in the property, which it will offer for lease for manufacturing and/or warehousing uses.

9. City Manager's Report, April 4, 2022 D. Legislative/Intergovernmental Update

City Manager has initiated discussions with the **U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Chicago District Office** about the funding recently approved for a "Determination of Federal Interest" in further study and possible capital investment in the Corps' Lake Michigan harbor infrastructure at Two Rivers.

Specifically: study and capital investment in the harbor entry structures to **mitigate storm surge and shoaling** in the harbor channel.

Corps representatives will be visiting the area in late April or May, and will meet with City reps and harbor users to discuss this issue.
