



3. Tour of Point Beach Nuclear Plant by City Representatives Today







- 4. New Emergency Siren Being Installed on Picnic Hill

In 2022, the City agreed to accept a donation of the emergency sirens that had been installed and maintained by Point Beach Nuclear Plant, which switched to a cell-phone based public emergency notification system.

In addition to the three sirens that have historically been located in the city limits, the City is installing a fourth siren, donated from the nuclear plant, at a location atop Picnic Hill. This will widen coverage for audible warnings of weather events and other emergencies—particularly when crowds gather in the Summer at the beach.

The installation is being completed by Emergency Communications Systems of Little Chute (2023 Capital Budget item).

With funding assistance from a WDNR Urban Forestry Grant, the City in April will be undertaking a community-wide inventory of all "public trees" located on City parks and other properties, as well as along city streets.

Blue Stream forestry has been contracted to do this work for the City, The inventory will be used to help manage Two Rivers urban forest assets.


