

#### On tonight's agenda:

Proposed Tax Incremental Financing, Property Sale, Cash Grant and Developer's Performance Agreement
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Developer, YBR Properties, LLC proposes for purchase just over one acre of the 3.5 acre site, to construct a new, 50-unit market rate apartment building at an estimated cost of \$13 million.

YBR Properties, LLC, working with CR Structures as the construction contractor, is also the developer for the Brin project and Banta Village in Menasha (See photos on next slide)

#### On tonight's agenda:

Proposed Tax Incremental Financing, Property Sale, Cash Grant and Developer's Performance Agreement --To assist with redevelopment of a portion of the former Eggers Industries downtown plant site, now owned by the City

#### **KEY TERMS FOR AGREEMENT UNDER CONSIDERATION:**

- Sale of a portion of the City-owned property (1-1.4 acres) to Developer
- Option for purchase of second portion of the property by Developer
- Financial Assistance from Tax Incremental District 16 to Developer (to be funded from additional property tax revenue created by project, captured by TID 16:
  - 1. Up-front grant of \$900,000 from funds to be borrowed by City (to be paid out in four equal installments as project progresses)
  - 2. "Pay as you go" grant of \$900,000, to be paid from annual TID 16 revenues AFTER first covering debt service on the above borrowing
  - 3. Possible "incentive bonus payments," totaling up to \$450,000 total, if the project generates TID 16 revenues exceeding what is estimate in TID 16 Project Plan (exceeding \$145,318 annually)

- Developer Plans and proof of financing to City by January 1, 2023
- Construction to start by May 1, 2023
- Project completion by December 31, 2024

## **Central Park West 365 Fund-Raising Update**




Toward the project goal of \$800,000, donations and pledges totaling \$746,071 have been received to date.
