# 9. CITY MANAGER'S REPORT B. STATUS UPDATE/REPORTS 3. FINAL PAYMENT TO VINTON CONSTRUCTION UNDER 2017 TID NO. 11 DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT

The 6<sup>th</sup> and final payment was made to Vinton – Two Rivers, LLC on February 29, completing the City's commitment to provide \$200,000 plus 5% interest in TID 11 development assistance to this project.

Vinton invested over \$1 million in the renovation of the former St. Peter the Fisherman School at 1322 33<sup>rd</sup> Street-at the time a tax-exempt "white elephant" property--converting it to corporate offices now assessed at \$839,400.






