The TRFSC Board of Directors met this week with a handful of current season pass holders and made the incredibly difficult decision that 2023 will be our last season. For the last 55+ years our establishment has provided families with a fun, safe place to spend time and most importantly to learn water safety.

Our facility has been completely run by our Board of Directors and volunteers. After our recent state inspection, it is becoming more clear that we cannot continue to operate this way. Discussing as a group and the age of the facility, the cost and time of a site plan would only fix a temporary problem when we need a long-term solution. Our facility is old and our end goal is to have a new facility which our Board cannot take on alone.

Our next steps will be to meet with the city to help us in achieving a new facility for our community. Our goal, along with your help, is to show the city how crucial it is to have a community pool for our children to learn to swim in a safe environment, possible tourism attraction, and benefiting our local families.
