

In early spring, the Committee on Aging discussed the issue of available affordable housing that is currently plaguing not only our seniors, but our community as a whole. Kyle Korinek, from the Two Rivers School District was able to give us some student statistics: 56 children have reported that they are homeless to the school district of Two Rivers. It is expected that the actual number of students that would be considered homeless is about 3x that amount.

After the meeting, the conversation continued and many asked What can we (the Senior Center) do to help? That is where the idea of a school supply carnival was born. Members, volunteers, and staff of the senior center, along with City staff, businesses and other citizens all pitched in to donate supplies to our carnival.







Based on 2022 Sales, The Value of Existing Residential Properties In Two Rivers Increased by 19 percent




TWO RIVERS City Council Meeting - August 7, 2023 City of Two Rivers' total equalized value jumped up by 16 percent, propelled by a 19 percent increase in the value of existing residential properties, a rate that outpaced the rest of the county. (Increases were 14% and 15% for the County and City of Manitowoc, respectively) New construction totaled a modest \$2.36 million.

The value of existing commercial properties dropped by 4 percent. New development, to add to the local tax base and help pay the bills for local services, remains a priority. But DOR's numbers confirm that there is strong demand for local housing, as we see in the home sales happening every day.




