STORE AND DISPOSE OF HOUSEHOLD TRASH PROPERLY--AND OUT OF VIEW

The City's Solid Waste Ordinance (Title 5, Chapter 6) includes requirements that:

- Refuse be stored in "watertight, rodent proof containers"—
 that is, trash cans with lids. Refuse can only be placed
 outdoors in garbage bags when placed at the street or alley
 for collection.
- Both trash cans and recycling containers must, except when
 placed at the street or alley for collection, be kept as far as
 possible out of public view. In no case shall such containers be
 stored in the front yard or in the street side yard of a corner
 property.
- Trash and recyclables can be placed at the side of the street or alley no earlier than noon on the day before collection; empty containers must be removed by the day following collection.
- Refuse shall not accumulate on any property. Quantities in excess of what will fill a 32-gallon garbage bag or container must be disposed of within one week.
