Fundraising Update: Central Park West 365 Project

Consider a donation to this project that will make Two Rivers an even more attractive place to live, work, raise a family, visit, and do business.

Sponsorships for park features are available and will be assigned based on the order in which the donations are received. There's also a "Buy a Paver" program, for pavers to be placed in front of the new bandstand.

The \$1.6 million project is being supported with \$500,000 in City funding and a West Foundation grant for \$300,000. That leaves \$800,000 to be funded through community donations.
