



We Still Need Your Support: Central Park West 365 Project

This \$1.6 million project is being 50 percent supported with \$500,000 in City funding and a West Foundation grant for \$300,000. That leaves \$800,000 to be funded through community donations.

To date, about \$520,000 has been committed from community donors; that's nearly two-thirds of our goal. We need to raise another \$280,000 by July to move the project forward to construction in the Fall of 2022 and Spring 2023. Dedication is planned for July 2023.

X If your vehicle is dismantled, does not operate, and/or is unregistered and kept in view for 72 hours or more this is a "junked vehicle" and is considered a public nuisance. Non-operational vehicles should be stored in an enclosed structure like a garage.
