

## POWER COST ADJUSTMENT ON ELECTRIC BILLS CONTINUES DOWNWARD TREND

After hitting an unusually high level in August, due to several factors that increased the cost of electricity purchased at wholesale by the electric utility, the PCAC (power cost adjustment clause) on electric bills dropped in September, and is dropping again for power consumed in October.

The chart at the right, from the website of the Public Service Commission of WI, shows monthly bills for this year at a consumption level of 600 kilowatt hours per month.

### NOTICE TO CUSTOMERS OF TWO RIVERS MUNICIPAL UTILITIES

The electric consumption used for residential purposes is exempt from State Sales tax during the months of November through April per Wisconsin Statute 77.54. It is possible that some of the electric consumption of our commercial or large power customers is being used for residential purposes and would be exempt from the sales tax. If you are presently paying the commercial or large power rate and feel that some of that consumption is used for residential purposes and would like more information on how to file an exempt certificate, please contact the Customer Service Office at 920-793-5546.

Please note that it is not necessary to call if you are already paying the residential rate because we give the exempt status to all residential customers during the period allowed by law.
