TWO RIVERS LEAF COLLECTION SCHEDULE

Beginning Monday, October 18, 2021

Mondays East Side
Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays.....North Side (between rivers)
Fridays South Side

This schedule will be adhered to as closely as possible. Any section not completed during a week will be given priority during the next time scheduled for that area. Leaf pick up continues until around Thanksgiving. It will be discontinued before that if there is snow. Because of the type of equipment used for pickup, all leaves must be deposited in the gutter, **NOT ON THE TERRACE AREA.** Bagged leaves will not be picked up. Grass clippings, branches, sod, and other yard waste will not be collected. These items must be taken to one of the Manitowoc County Yard Waste Sites.
