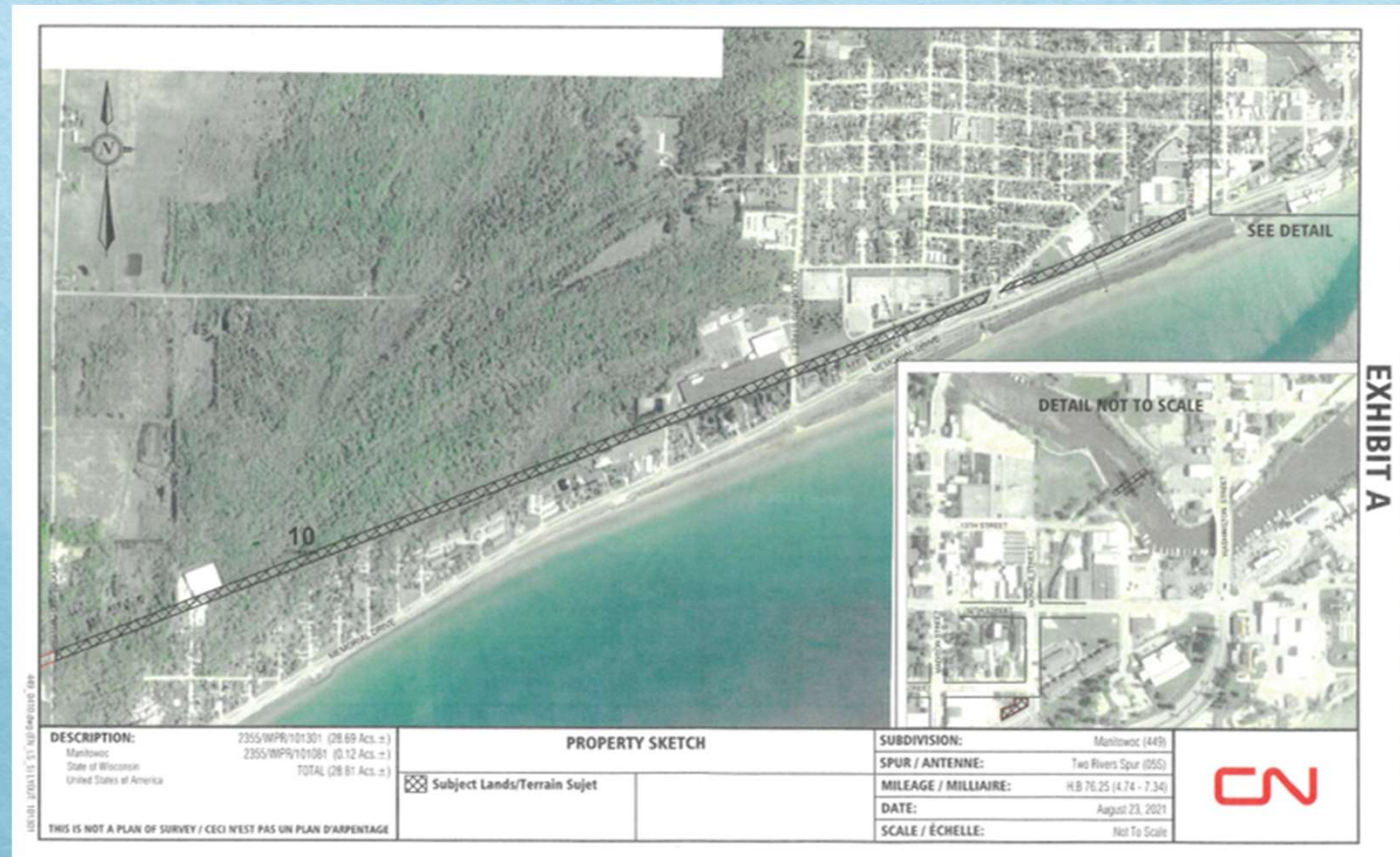

Dear property owner:

This is to notify you of upcoming construction work on Monroe Street, between 16<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> Street. Our contractor, Mammoth Construction, will be replacing Lead Service Laterals along Monroe Street, between 16<sup>th</sup> Street and 22<sup>nd</sup> Street. This work will require pavement removal, replacement of water and sewer service lines at various locations, and pavement replacement.

The roadway will be closed to through traffic, although it will remain open to local traffic for access to driveways and businesses. Traffic will be detoured along 16<sup>th</sup> Street, to Washington Street, to 22<sup>nd</sup> Street. In addition, the cross streets are expected to remain open at the intersections.

This work is scheduled to begin July 7, 2025, and continue through August 15. Project updates will be posted on the Two Rivers Website at:

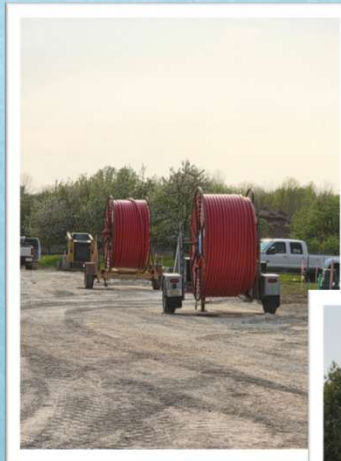

**GRANT DETAILS & REQUIREMENTS**  
Energized Education grants provide opportunities for educators to enhance their teaching capabilities regarding energy related topics.  
These competitive grants can be applied for up to \$8,000. Selection is based on the strength of topic, potential impact, and application for learners.

- Topics may include, but are not limited to, renewable energy, careers in the energy industry, energy efficiency, new energy technologies, energy engineering, electrification, and more.
- Teachers (preschool through grade 12), librarians and government entities are eligible and encouraged to apply.

**GRANT DOLLARS AND PROJECT OPPORTUNITIES**  
Grants can be used for classroom materials, resources, and experiences.

- Each school district can be awarded no more than one grant per school year.
- This grant program strongly encourages educators with their own projects in mind to apply. Potential ideas to also consider and expand on:
  - Renewable energy classroom materials
  - Alternative/innovative energy classroom materials
  - Tours of energy generation locations
  - Formation of school green team and needed resources
  - Classroom speakers related to the energy industry and careers
  - Field trips related to applicable energy topics

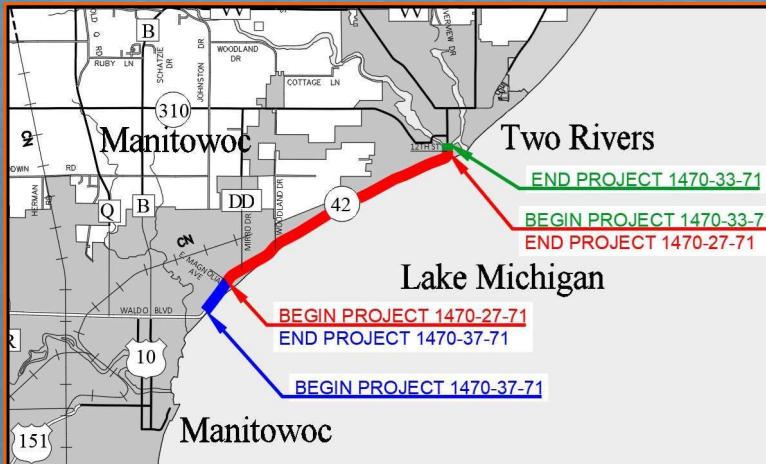

- Traffic in both directions has fully reopened. Aside from a few small details, the project is completed.

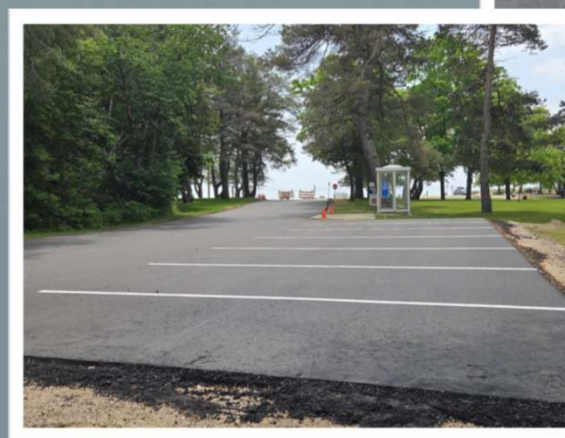

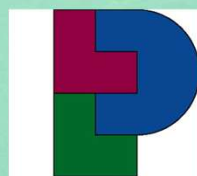

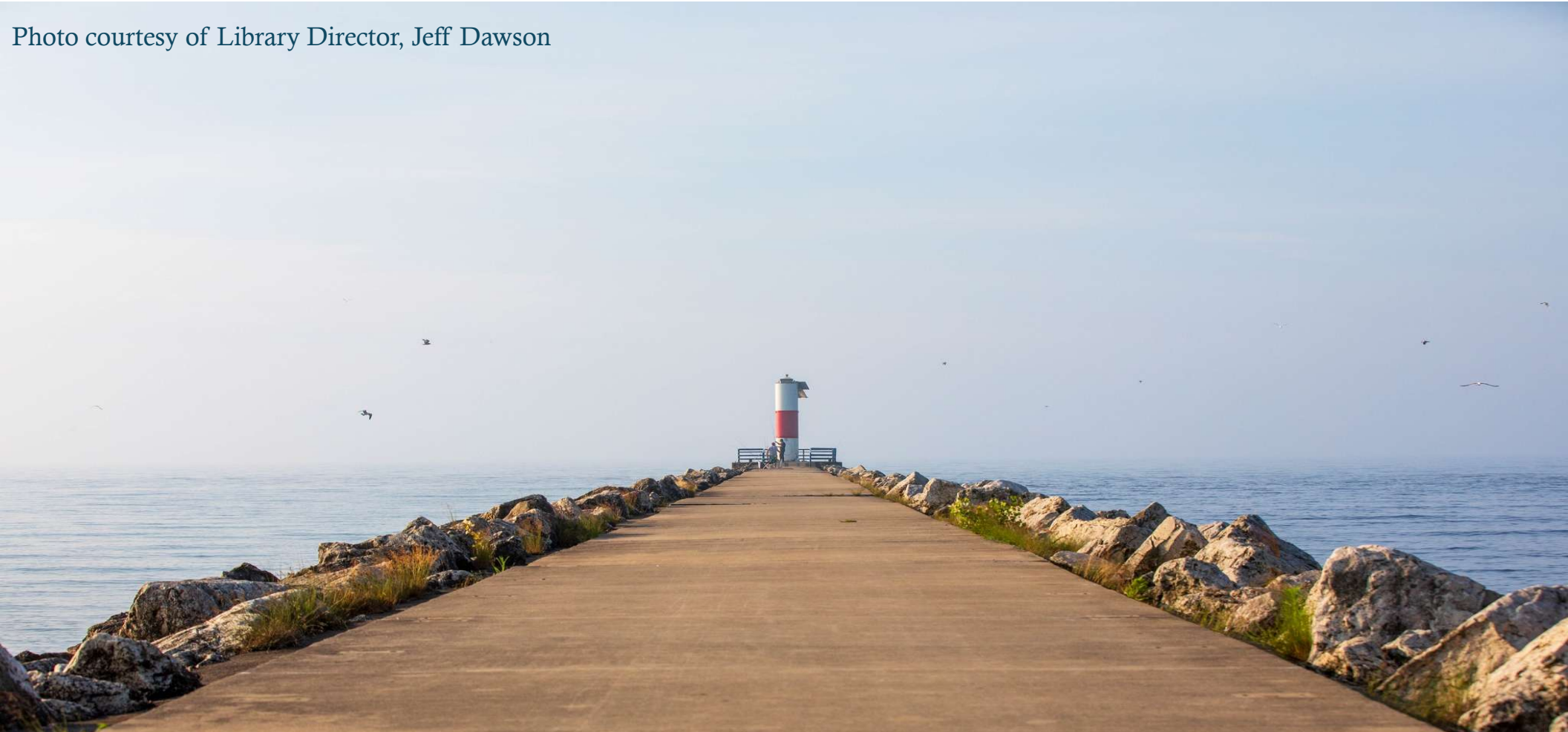
