Reminder: Keep Turf Grass Cut to a Height No Greater Than 8 Inches

Please keep your property looking good and free of vermin by keeping lawn areas mowed regularly.

City Ordinance 9-3-4 requires that lawns be kept to a height not to exceed 8 inches; in addition, property owners must keep noxious and nuisance weeds under control.

Failure to maintain lawns as required by this ordinance may result in a forfeiture. For the first violation in any year, the forfeiture is \$75. If the grass is not cut in not within five days following the mailing of a violation notice. In addition, the City may arrange for mowing of the property and bill the owner for its costs, if the grass/weeds have not been addressed within those five days.

For subsequent violations in the same year on the same property, the forfeiture increases to \$150 (with no grace period) and the City may still mow the grass and bill for that work if the condition is not corrected within five days after mailing of a violation notice.

Projects include improvements to the Jaycees shelter, installation of new climbing structures for older kids, and constructing new paved walkways across the park, from Garfield Street to Pierce and from Pierce to the back of beach house. 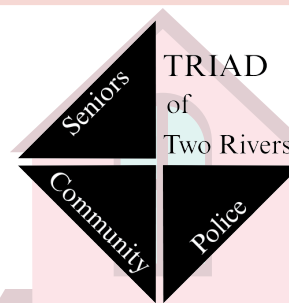

TIPS FROM TRIAD

Ordinance Reminder:

Rummage/Garage sales: Sales cannot exceed four consecutive days of operation. A maximum of two sales are allowed per calendar year.

Rummage/Garage sales signs: One sale sign per property is allowed with the owner's permission. Signs may not be erected more than 24 hours in advance to the sale and must be removed no later than 96 hours after the start of a sale. Signs may not exceed three feet in height nor six square feet in area. The signs may not be placed in the terrace (the area between the sidewalk and the curb), attached to right-of-way signs, or to vehicles parked on a city street.
