ADRC: No Report

City Council: John Casavant reported Captain Lee Stadler retired from the Two Rivers Fire Department and Act. Captain Eric Isselman has been promoted to Captain. The City of Two Rivers closed of the sale of the Blue Goose property located on the corner of River and Jefferson Streets. Two Water and Light employees are in St Croix, Virgin Islands helping to bring electricity to people on the island. The residents on the island have been without power for over 3 months due to the destruction caused by the hurricanes.

Parks & Recreation: No Report

Senior Center: Tammy Desten gave an update on the mixed nut fundraising sale, currently selling the 8th barrel of nuts. The Senior Center will soon be selling chocolate covered almonds, 1 lb bags for \$5.00. Both holiday parties were well attended; 190 Christmas Party and 130 New Year's Party.
