Call to Order

Introductions of Joint Review Board Members, City Staff and Guests

Review and discussion of proposed Project Plan and Boundaries for TID No. 14; Statutory finds and necessary for approval of the Project Plan and Boundaries for TID No. 14

Ms. Runge reviewed the proposed project plan and boundaries for TID No. 14 at the Woodland Industrial Park to spur growth and development. The TID 14 District is approximately 229.05 acres, of which is 100% is zoned Industrial. The project expenditures include a cash grant to a developer in the amount of \$250,000 to be provided on a "pay-as-you-go" basis to assist with the land purchase and construction costs for a new build in the Woodland Industrial Park. Additional expenditures include additional assistance for others to develop in the industrial park, and infrastructure expenditures to support future development.
