Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Committee Chairman Mark Bittner at 5:11 p.m.

January Overtime Report

Finance Director, Dave Buss, reviewed the overtime report for January 2021 and a comparison year-to-date of 2021 and 2020. The general fund overtime total for January 2021 is approximately \$14,000 lower than the same period last year.

Preliminary 2020 Year-End Operating Results

Dave Buss reviewed the fund balance over the prior three audited years, 2017-2019, and the projected fund balance for 2020.

There is a projected \$200,000 increase in General Fund fund balance, thanks to an operating surplus in 2020. There are also significant reductions in the deficit cash balances of several funds. Such deficits, which get reported as advances to those funds by the General Fund in year-end balance sheets, declined by more than \$1.1 million from the prior year. As the result, the General Fund's "unassigned" fund balance has improved considerably. A more detailed update to the City Council will be provided by the Finance Director at a March meeting.
