What Is Neighborhood Watch?

Neighborhood Watch is a crime prevention program which requires the active participation of citizens in cooperation with their police department with a goal of reducing crime in their neighborhood.

It involves neighbors working together in a program of mutual assistance. The program focus is neighbors looking out for each other and reporting suspicious activity.

It is the responsibility of participants to report all suspicious activity to the Police.

What should I be looking for?

- Any person(s) who are acting suspicious
 - Looking into vehicles
 - Appear to be selling drugs/stolen items
 - Selling items at very low prices (stolen goods)
 - Carrying merchandise at odd hours (i.e. at night).
 - Entering/exiting areas where people should not be (closed business or unoccupied homes).
 - Adults approaching a child who appears to be resisting the adults advances (on foot or in a vehicle).
 - A man or woman approaching another who appears to be resisting their advances.
- Short term vehicle traffic and vehicles that do not belong in your neighborhood.

What do I do?

- Call the police immediately at 920-686-7200 or 911 if it is an emergency
- Describe observations to the police dispatcher
 - Who, what, where, when, and how
- Give a detailed description of the person
 - Race,gender,clothing description, hair
- Provide vehicle information
 - Make, model, color, license plate number
 - Any specific details
 - Damage
 - Decals or stickers
