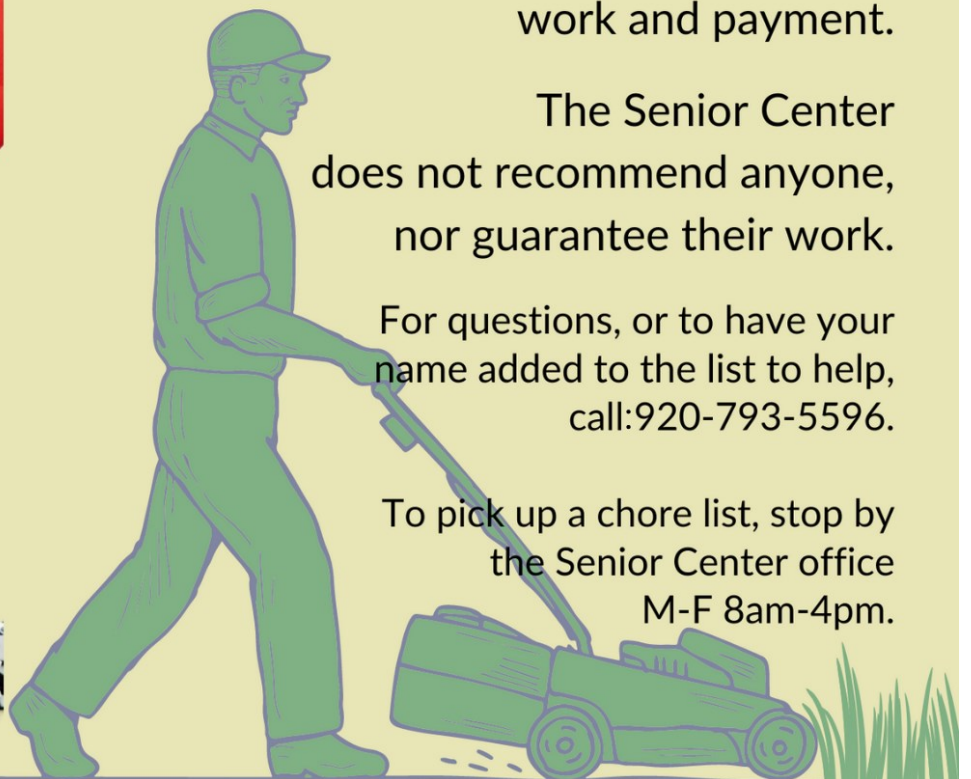
## PEOPLE HELPING PEOPLE CHORE PROGRAM

**The Two Rivers Senior Center TRUST car is available to take you to do all of your Two Rivers errands, whether shopping, social, or medical.**

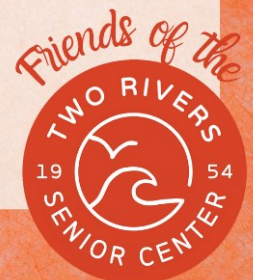
This service is for members of the Senior Center who are living in Two Rivers.
