TWO RIVERS SENIOR CENTER BUS TRIP POLICIES

TRIP SIGN UP- Sign up for trips will begin as soon as the trip is announced in our newsletter. Stop in or mail in your payment to reserve your spot. You may reserve a spot for others.

CANCELLATION POLICY- Cancellations for trips can be accepted up to two weeks prior to the trip. Reservations are non– transferable unless authorized by the Senior Center office. Refunds cannot be issued if a participant cannot make a trip. If a cancellation is made, participants on the wait list may be contacted.

INSURANCE- Insurance my be offered for extended trips. Trip insurance covers things like illness or injury before or during a trip, or other unforeseen circumstances that may require you to cancel your trip.

FUEL SURCHARGE- Due to fluctuating gas prices, a surcharge may be necessary. If a fuel surcharge is needed, participants will be notified as soon as the fuel rate is locked in. At that time, participants may choose to get a refund for their trip, or to pay the additional charge to remain on the trip.

DAY TRIP BUS LOADING ORDER- Participants will be called to board the vehicle in the order that they signed up for the trip. There may be seats reserved in the front or back of the bus for medical reasons.

MEDICAL- Any medical accommodations can be made per physician's order. Accommodations by physician's order can be kept on file in the senior center office. Participants must be independent or travel with a caregiver. In the case of an illness, a trip escort will ensure participants receive proper medical care, but the escort is required to stay with the group.

TRIP CHANGES- While all care is taken to keep the scheduled itinerary, there may be an occasion when a substitution is made due to unforeseen circumstances.
