## Guidelines:

- 1. To be eligible, the student, their parent or their legal guardian must be a customer of Two Rivers Utilities.
- 2. Must be a high school senior, graduating 2024.
- 3. High school seniors may apply for one or both of the \$500 scholarships.
  - Energy Industry Scholarship The student must be planning to attend a Technical or Academic College or University that offers courses related to (but not limited to) the Energy Industry. For example: Electrical Power Distribution; Electrical Engineering; Nuclear Power; Renewable Energy
  - General Education Scholarship The student must be planning to attend a Technical College, Academic College, or University.
- 4. The deadline for submitting applications is **April 5, 2024.** Applications may be mailed, dropped off or emailed to:
